- Definition of Replenishment Area – revisions requested

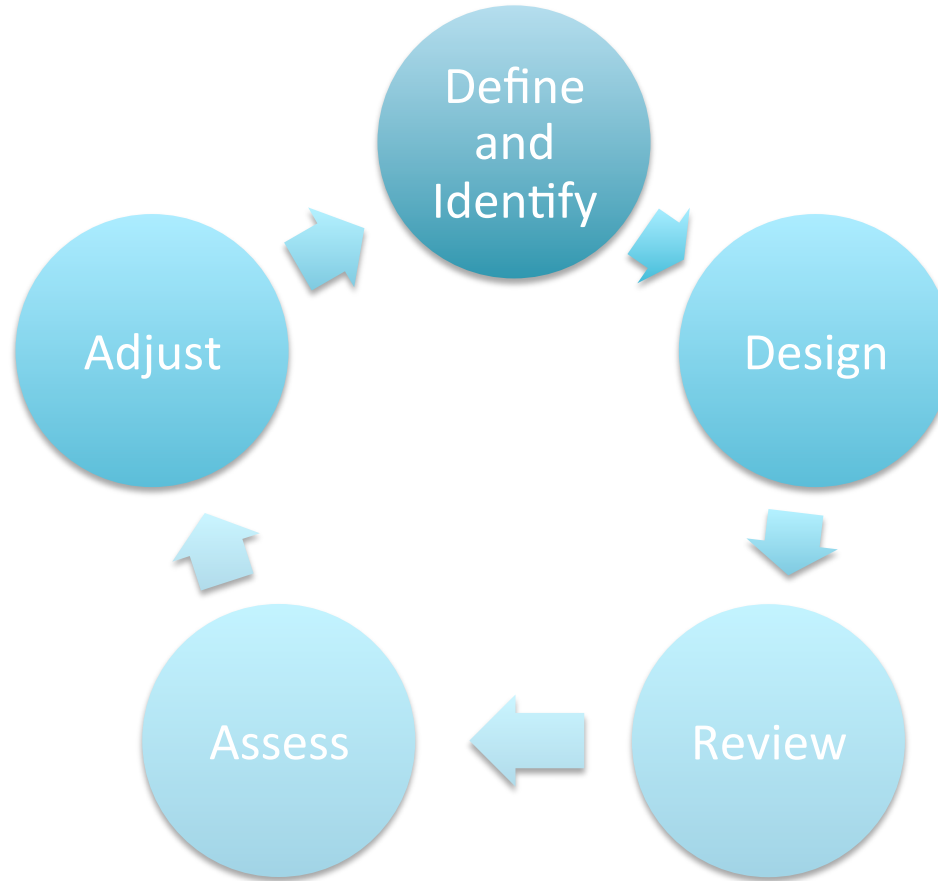
